

# Gins

## Adnams Copper House 40% £3.20

Launched November 2010 and infused with six botanicals, this is an aromatic gin with classic notes of juniper, alongside sweet orange and hibiscus flowers.

## Adnams First Rate 48 % £4.40

Launched November 2010, taking only the purest cut from their handmade copper pot still. Infused with a complex blend of thirteen botanicals, this is silky-smooth and balanced.

## Blackwood's 40% £2.90

A top quality gin made using botanicals from Shetland, including wild water mint, meadowsweet and sea pink flowers. Blackwood's is also unusual in that it is released with a vintage statement for each small batch distilled.

## Martin Miller 40% £2.90

Distilled just outside of London, using over eight botanicals and aromatics, and then sent to be blended with soft Icelandic Spring Water. Sweet candied lemon peel and floral aromas.

## Plymouth 41.2% £2.70

Is the only 18<sup>th</sup> Century gin still batch distilled in the original distillery, Black Friars, Plymouth. A unique style of gin that differs from London gins due to the use of a special blend containing only sweet botanicals.

## Gordon's 37.5% £2.70

Created over 200 years ago by Alexander Gordon, giving a clean, distinctive taste created using whole herbs and spices.

## Bombay Sapphire 40% £2.80

This particular Bombay only appeared on the market in the 1990's, using ten different herbs and botanicals.

## Bombay Original 40% £3.00

One of the great old-school style London Gins, first introduced in 1959. The precursor of the now more famous Bombay Sapphire

## Tanqueray 43.1% £3.00

Crafted using a time honoured recipe of only the highest quality grains, the purest water, the most select Juniper berries, finest botanicals, and a unique quadruple distillation process.

## Tanqueray No.10 47.3% £3.50

A fresh bracing aroma emanates and a smooth crisp finish can be enjoyed from this gin. Bright citrus flavours such as grapefruit, orange and lime are mixed harmoniously with juniper and accented by the slightest tease of soothing camomile.

## Hendricks 41.4% £3.45

Is a small batch, handcrafted gin, distilled in Ayrshire, Scotland, with a deliciously odd set of infusions. Made with hints of coriander, juniper, citrus peel, rose petals and the infusion of cucumber. The taste is clean and refreshing, yet unusually rich for a gin.

## Beefeater 40% £2.50

A dry, complex gin, whose citric notes are balanced with hints of caramel, juniper, coriander and orange peel. The only London gin to be made in London, in Kennington, since the early 19<sup>th</sup> Century. upbeat.

## The Duke Munich Dry 40% £5.25

A fairly traditional gin with two unique differences – 1, it's made in Germany, and 2, to compliment it's 13 other botanicals it also contains Bavarian hops.

## 11 Gocker Riesling France [2]

Classic Alsace Riesling with a strong fruit flavour and a slightly smoked taste.

## 12 Gocker Gewurztraminer Alsace [3]

Light, soft, exotic fruit salad nose. Beautifully perfumed style with broad, spicy flavours.

## 13 Gocker Pinot Gris Alsace [2]

It's great depth, balanced by crisp acidity that gives structure and longevity. A smokiness combined with underlying delicacy, is a typical trait.

## 14 Martin Codax Albarino Rias Baixas Spain [2]

On the nose this wine is intense, aromatic and elegant with aromas of fresh herbs, green apples, peach and grapefruit. On the palate it is persistent, round, full bodied and fresh.

Incredible mineral complexity with ripe, almost honeyed fruit.

An excellent and classic nettle Sancerre, with a delicate perfume. Clean, refreshing and elegant.

Lifted aromatics combined with good depth on the palate that is balanced by minerally fruit and zingy acidity

From an area that has a higher proportion of limestone. The resulting wine is rich, yet steely, fermented entirely in stainless steel to preserve the purity of the fruit.
